## OVERVIEW

FGS MOSEL was commissioned in 1993 and is the second ship of the ELBE class of a total of six, operated by the German Navy. She is named after the river Mosel. Built as an auxiliary unit to support smaller naval vessels, FGS MOSEL and her sister units have proven themselves as multi purpose naval units over the years, representing the German Navy in a multitude of international deployments.

She is armed with two 27mm MLG rapid fire guns. In addition she is equipped with 12.7mm heavy machine guns and Stinger anti aircraft rockets. Furthermore equipped with a flight deck she can provide landing capability for helicopters.

FGS MOSEL joined OP. SOPHIA in May 2018.
