OVERVIEW

ITS SAN MARCO is the second ship of the SAN GIORGIO class, it was launched in 1987 and its port of assignment is the Italian Naval Base of Brindisi.

Since its delivery, the ITS San Marco has been employed in many operations and training activities that have always confirmed its high flexibility as multirole platform. The ship is a LPD (Landing Platform Dock), and is designed to constitute an amphibious unit, with floodable dock, which is primarily designed to perform operations of capacity projection to sea and from sea to land. It can be deployed not only for military operations but also for logistic support and health care purposes. The ship can accommodate up to 508 people including the ship crew, the flight crew, marines and navy seals.

The unit can in fact be easily adapted for tasks such as health care (medical and logistics); transport of special vehicles (kitchens, field hospitals, power generators, containers, etc .. evacuation of the civilian population by sea and by helicopters.) In view of this use was also made with funds from the Civil Protection with the contribution of the Ministry of 'Indoor.
